- ❖ Have the children divided equally into the proper number of groups before arriving.
- ❖ Let all adults know their responsibility for PARTICIPATION and DISCIPLINE.
  - Silence cell phones and refrain from cell phone use.
  - Assist LCFPD staff and volunteers as needed.
  - Support LCFPD staff and volunteers by reinforcing classroom behavior expectations.
- ❖ So that all learners can enjoy the visit, please let us know if any students are ESL learners or have a health condition or disability so we and you can make the necessary reasonable modifications to assure a safe and enjoyable experience for all.
- ❖ Remind the children to dress for the weather; we spend as much time outdoors as possible.
- ❖ Check maps to program sites; call if you have questions about locations.
