BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE DISTRICT – RESCHEDULED REGULAR MARCH MEETING MINUTES MARCH 13, 2024

The Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District met on Wednesday, March 13, 2024 at the District General Offices, 1899 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois.
