













Fishing 1

Dates: July 7-11, July 14-18, and August 4-8

Times: Please drop your child off no earlier than 8:20 am. Fishing 1 starts at 8:30 am and pick-up is at 11:30 am.

Location: Independence Grove Forest Preserve, North Bay Pavilion. Visit https://www.lcfpd.org/IG/ for more information about this site.

What to Wear: Sturdy closed toed shoes that can get wet/muddy, hat, and sunglasses. Sunscreen and bug spray are optional. Please apply before entering the Pavilion.

What to Bring: Water Bottle. It's preferred that your child <u>not</u> bring their own poles, tackle, etc.

The daily list below does not include everything that will be discussed and demonstrated. Each day will include 1.5 hours of fishing.

Monday: The week begins with introductions, local fish ecology, gear & tackle introduction, fish location, casting practice, and an overview of spin cast and spinning reels.

Tuesday: Today we will learn to rig a worm pole set-up, make a barbless hook, tie a clinch knot, and learn techniques for hook removal.

Wednesday: We start the day with casting a spinning rod, a demonstration of how to place line on a spool, another demonstration of largemouth bass lures, how to bait a hook with a minnow, and building a slip bobber rig for crappies and bass.

Thursday: We kick off the day with crafting a Texas Rig, Ned Rig and Wacky Rig, introduction to trailer hooks and discuss lead head, floating jigs, and how to tie a Snell Knot.

Friday: Our day begins with a casting game, how to tie a Palomar Knot, make a drop shot rig, followed by a wrap up of the week's events.

Program Cancellation: In the event of storms, I will inform you of a cancelation early in the morning by a text message or a phone call. On rare occasions, when storms pop up, persist, or lighting is in the area for over 40 minutes, we will have to end the session. **Please** be near your cell phone during inclement weather days for possible child pick up. If you have questions or concerns, you can call me as early as 6:30 am.
