BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE DISTRICT – REGULAR OCTOBER MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 9, 2024

Antioch Moda I, LLC is the current owner of the adjacent property on which the residential development is occurring, therefore it is appropriate to add this party to the settlement agreement.
