- Fort Sheridan Use Survey: This summer the Public Affairs Division oversaw a Public Use Survey at Fort Sheridan Forest Preserve, working with Lake Forest College (LFC) students under the direction of LFC Liberal Arts & Business Professor Jeffry Sundberg. The survey included only five questions: where visitors live; how visitors traveled to Fort Sheridan; what activities visitors planned to do at the preserve; frequency of visits to Fort Sheridan; and length of stay on an individual visit. Surveys were collected on both weekdays and weekends, at various times of day; 573 surveys were completed and a summary report was prepared by the students.
