



Public Safety Monthly Report

August 17, 2015 – September 20, 2015

Accidents

- Officers responded to Grant Woods on report of a hit and run accident in which our entry gate was damaged. Vehicle and driver located at a second accident site and driver arrested for driving under the influence.

Alarms

- Officers responded to multiple burglar alarms at Independence Grove Visitor Center. Building checked and alarm reset.
- Rangers responded to an activated fire alarm at the Independence Grove Maintenance Shop for a battery fire. Fire department extinguished the fire.
- Officers responded to Countryside for multiple burglar alarms. Alarm reported for service.
- Officers responded to Brae Loch for multiple burglar alarms. Buildings checked and alarms reset.
- Officers responded to Rollins Savanna for an activated burglar alarm. Building checked and alarm reset.

Animal Complaints

- Officers responded to Greenbelt for aggressive dogs complaint. No dogs were found.
- Officers located two loose German Shepherds at Grant Woods. Officers returned animals to owner and issued warning.

Arrests

- Officers arrested a male at Lakewood for possession of drug paraphernalia.
- Officers arrested a male at Lyons Woods for possession of cannabis and ecstasy.
- Officers arrested a driver for possession of crack cocaine and drug paraphernalia at Old School.

Assist Other Agencies

- Officers assisted rescue on the Des Plaines River Trail north of Independence Grove where a rider fell off his bicycle due to travelling too fast. Bicyclist transported for treatment.
- Officers located a highly intoxicated male at Greenbelt and rescue transported the person to the hospital after he could not stand or provide any information.
- Officers assisted rescue at Countryside Golf Club where a female golfer became disoriented and confused. Golfer transported for treatment.
- Officers assisted rescue at Van Patten where a rider fell from her horse. Rider transported for treatment.
- Officers assisted rescue at Fox River where a boater had caught his arm in a propeller. Boater transported for treatment.
- Officers assisted rescue at Independence Grove where a child caught their foot in the spokes of their bicycle. Child transported for treatment.

Service Calls/ Crime Reports

- Officers responded to Old School and Half Day for four burglaries to motor vehicles. Suspect/s broke door windows and removed cash, purses, wallets, and electronics that were left in the vehicles.
- Officers responded to Prairie Wolf DEA for two burglaries to motor vehicle. Suspect/s broke door windows and removed cash and a purse left in the vehicles.
- Officers are investigating a suspicious incident at Van Patten. Crews located girl's underwear and condoms in the trash.
