SUBJECT: Award of Farm Licenses

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the award of nine Farm Licenses to the highest qualified bidders.

BACKGROUND: The farming program is conducted with local farmers to provide cost-effective, interim land use and management until the District is ready to convert farmland to other forest preserve purposes. Nine of the current license agreements are due to expire on December 31, 2015. Farm licenses were advertised on September 9, 2015 and nine bids were received. All licenses were advertised for 4-year terms. The highest qualified bidders for each parcel are noted below:

One parcel, Oak Hickory – Hay, did not receive any bids at the bid opening. However, shortly thereafter, Michael Kelly contacted the District to inquire about the status of the parcel and its availability. Mr. Kelly has offered \$54.00/acre to farm this parcel.

Only one of the Highest Bidders listed above is new to the District's Farm Program. Fred Brown, of Arthur Brown Bushing Trust, is aware of the District's Farm Program requirements and has agreed to comply with all obligations. All other Highest Bidders listed have farmed Forest Preserve land in the past and have complied with program requirements.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION: Committee approval is required in accordance with District policy.

FINANCIAL DATA: Awarding the nine licenses will generate \$117,566.82 annually, and will be credited to the Farmland Management Fund (28642500-403000). Revenue generated by these licenses in 2015 was \$111,515.10.
