SUBJECT: Native Seed Purchase for Grassy Lake Forest Preserve Phase I Restoration

RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of a Resolution awarding a Contract for the Purchase of Native Seed for Grassy Lake Forest Preserve to Prairie Moon Nursery, Winona, Wisconsin, in the Contract Price of \$47,146.45, and Shooting Star Native Seeds, Spring Grove, Minnesota, in the Contract Price of \$27,759.35.

BACKGROUND: The District will be installing native seed at the newly opened section of Grassy Lake Forest Preserve as part of ongoing ecological restoration efforts. Prairie and woodland seed will be broadcast within the 50 acres where dense stands of invasive woody and herbaceous species were controlled last year. The growth of a diverse, showy mix of native species will enhance the site's wildlife habitat values, increase competitive forces necessary to limit weed spread, and provide year-long enjoyment to preserve-users on the newly opened trail.

The project was advertised on October 23, 2015 and 5 bids were received. A summary of the lowest bids received is listed below:

Materials were bid on a unit price per species. Staff has awarded a contract to each of the 3 low bidders whose total bids are less than \$20,000.00. Staff recommends that Prairie Moon Nursery and Shooting Star Native Seeds be awarded contracts as the lowest responsible bidders for the species for which they are the low bidders. The total of their low bids is greater than \$20,000.00, thus requiring Committee recommendation and Board approval of the contracts for those bids. Work is anticipated to begin January 2016 and be completed by March 2016.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION: Committee recommendation and Board approval are required in accordance with District policy.

FINANCIAL DATA: This project was approved as part of the adopted FY 2014/2015 Capital Improvement Plan in the amount of \$2,282,989.00. The total amount of the contracts with Prairie Moon Nursery, Shooting Star Native Seeds, and the three contracts already awarded by staff is \$94,481.79, which will be charged to account 35634100-803200-60701. This portion of the project was estimated at \$120,000.00.

**A RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF NATIVE SEED FOR
THE HABITAT RESTORATION PROJECT AT GRASSY LAKE FOREST PRESERVE**

WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the “District”) has advertised in The News Sun for sealed bids to purchase native seed for the Habitat Restoration Project at Grassy Lake Forest Preserve (the “Products”); and

WHEREAS, all sealed bids were received and opened by the District at its General Offices, 1899 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois on November 5, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the District’s staff, the Purchasing Manager, the Director of Natural Resources, the Planning and Restoration Committee, and the Finance and Administrative Committee have reviewed the bids identified on Exhibit A and recommend that the Board of Commissioners find (i) Prairie Moon Nursery, Winona, Minnesota, to be the lowest responsible bidder with respect to the yellow highlighted bids on Exhibit A in the column labeled “Prairie Moon Nursery” (the “Prairie Moon Bids”), and (ii) Shooting Star Native Seeds, Spring Grove, Minnesota, to be the lowest responsible bidder with respect to the yellow highlighted bids on Exhibit A in the column labeled “Shooting Star” (the “Shooting Star Bids”), and award contracts for the Products to those bidders consistent therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that Prairie Moon Nursery and Shooting Star Native Seeds are the lowest responsible bidders for the Products, as set forth in the previous clause;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois, **THAT**:

Section 1: Recitals. The recitals set forth above are incorporated as part of this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2: Award of Contract. The Prairie Moon Bids in the total amount of \$47,146.45 (the “Prairie Moon Contract Price”) are hereby accepted and a contract for the Products in the amount of the Prairie Moon Contract Price is hereby awarded to Prairie Moon Nursery (the “Prairie Moon Contract”). The Shooting Star Bids in the total amount of \$27,759.35 (the “Shooting Star Contract Price”) are hereby accepted and a contract for the Products in the amount of the Shooting Star Contract Price is hereby awarded to Shooting Star Native Seeds (the “Shooting Star Contract”) (collectively, the Prairie Moon Contract and the Shooting Star Contract are the “Contracts”).

Section 3: Execution of Contracts. The Executive Director of the District is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Contracts in the amounts of the Prairie Moon Contract Price and the Shooting Star Contract Price.

Section 4: Payments. The District Treasurer shall make payments under the Contracts only pursuant to and in accordance with the Contracts' terms.

Section 5: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
