

# Public Safety Monthly Report February 18, 2016 – March 22, 2016

## **Accidents**

- Officers investigated three minor accidents where District property received damage at Lakewood Winter Sports, Raven Glen, and Grassy Lake.
- Officers investigated an accident at the Russell Road Canoe Launch where a semi-truck struck the entry gate.
  Officers cited the driver.

#### **Alarms**

• Officers responded to 22 activated burglar alarms during this period.

#### **Arrests**

• Officers responded to a disturbance at Buffalo Creek. Officers found a juvenile trying to snag ducks with a fishing lure. Juvenile turned over to parents for station adjustment and a written warning issued.

#### **Assist Other Agencies**

- Officers assisted Lake County Sheriff with a reckless driving/domestic situation at Fairfield and Old Oak Rd. and later at Fairfield and Bonner Rd.
- Officers assisted Lake County Sheriff with five vehicle crashes during this period.
- Officers assisted rescue at the Independence Grove playground where a six year old fell and cut his face. Rescue transported the child for treatment.

## **Crime Reports**

• Commonwealth Edison reported a stolen transformer from Dutch Gap where a building had been recently taken down. The transformer had been sitting at the location for several months.

#### **Service Calls**

- Officers responded to shots being fired at Rollins Savanna and Waukegan Savanna. The shots were not coming from District property.
- Officers checked a report of fuel oil in the stream at Fort Sheridan. Appears to be runoff from surrounding areas.
- Officers searched for and located two lost females in the area of Wright Woods and Half Day. Officers escorted them back to their vehicles.
- Officers located dumping issues at Cuba Marsh and Greenbelt.
- Officers located very large unescorted dogs at Lakewood, Van Patten, and Lakewood DEA during this period. All animals returned to owners or turned over to Animal Control.

#### **Encroachments**

- Resident at Dutch Gap cut down two cottonwood trees from District property while clearing along his property line. Officer spoke with resident and issued a warning.
- Resident at Grant Woods had debris and junk on District property. Officer made contact with resident to have the items removed.
- Officers checked out a small trail and dock placed at Grant Woods. Owner contacted by the officer to stop mowing and remove the dock.
