

OPERATIONS & INFRASTRUCTURE June 2016

Grounds Maintenance

- Conducted trail checks and trail repairs District-wide.
- Mowed turf and trail edges, applied herbicide and sodded bare spots at all preserves.
- Mulched and weeded all tree and flowerbeds at all preserves.
- Power washed comfort stations District-wide.
- Installed seasonal signage where needed.
- Performed maintenance day activities at all Dog Exercise Areas.
- Began startup of Native Garden pond and irrigation system at Independence Grove.
- Repaired paving bricks at the Discovery Museum.
- Maintained headstones at the Fort Sheridan Cemetery.
- Continued to move boats from storage at the Fox River Marina.
- Assisted in setup of a meeting rooms at Greenbelt.
- Moved furniture at the General Office and Ryerson.
- Provided event support for Kids Nature Fun Fest at Greenbelt.
- Provided setup before and cleanup after Summer Concert Series events at Independence Grove.
- Began preparation of site for Civil War Days at Lakewood.

Natural Resources

- Provided herbicide application at Dutch Gap, Ethel's Woods, Fort Sheridan, Fourth Lake, Gander Mountain, Grant Woods, Independence Grove, Marl Flat, Middlefork Savanna, Ray Lake, Rollins Savanna, Sequoit Creek, Singing Hills, Van Patten and Waukegan Savanna.

- Removed and addressed hazard trees at Fox River and Rollins Savanna.
- Provided chain saw safety training for the Youth Conservation Corp participants.

Infrastructure

- Repaired a water line leak at Nippersink.
