



Public Safety Monthly Report

May 26, 2016- June 15, 2016

Accidents

- Officers investigated a motor vehicle crash at the Operations and Public Safety Facility where a vehicle struck an overhead door.
- Officers took a report of a minor vehicle crash at Rollins Savanna off of Washington.

Arrests

- Officers arrested two males for damaging the bench on the sled hill at Old School.
- Officers cited a driver for no driver license and other traffic charges in the area of Everett and Saint Mary's Road.
- Officers cited a rider of a horse drawn cart on the trail at Lakewood.
- Officers cited a driver for driving with a suspended license near Fort Sheridan.
- Officers cited two people for public indecency at Independence Grove.

Assist Other Agencies

- Officers assisted rescue at Oak Spring Canoe Launch where a bicyclist fell and broke his collar bone. Rescue transported the injured party.
- Officers assisted Buffalo Grove PD in the area of Buffalo Creek searching for a suicidal subject. Officers located the subject and transported him to Buffalo Grove PD.
- Officers assisted Lake County Sheriff at Cuba Marsh searching for domestic violence offender armed with a knife. Subject not located at Cuba Marsh.
- Officers assisted rescue at Hastings Lake where a juvenile fell off a skate board. Rescue transported the juvenile for treatment.
- Officers assisted rescue at Independence Grove for male who cut his hand fishing. Refused transport.
- Officers assisted rescue at Half Day where a bicyclist broke his ankle. Rescue transported the rider.
- Officers assisted Barrington PD chasing a naked male at Cuba Marsh. Subject captured.

Crime Reports

- Officers received a battery report at Van Patten Shelter C. The male involved in the incident left the area prior to the officer arriving at the location. Incident is under investigation.
- Officers received a call of a burglary to motor vehicle at Prairie Wolf. Suspects broke a rear passenger window and removed two purses from the vehicle.
- Officers investigated a domestic battery at Independence Grove. No charges filed by victim.
- Officers received a delayed report of a burglary to motor vehicle. Suspects took prescription medicine and credit cards from an unlocked vehicle.
- Officers investigated graffiti in the comfort station at Grant Woods.

Service Calls

- Patrons found four stray dogs near Independence Grove, Prairie Wolf Slough, and Grant Woods. All animals turned over to Lake County Animal Control.
- Officers responded to a small group of protesters at the Discovery Museum at Lakewood handing out post cards and carrying signs. Protesters were advised of the expressive use ordinance and left the area.
- Officers located a bull running loose on the trails at Van Patten Woods. The bull had spooked a horse and a rider had fallen. Both the bull and horse are back with their owners.

Encroachments

- Grassy Lake: Mowing maintenance and dumping of yard waste. Fencing project on hold pending independent survey by the homeowner being completed.
- Old School: Dumping of hay and horse manure and creating a narrow access path to an equestrian trail belonging to Mettawa. Owner has cleaned up and stopped the activity.
- Sun Lake: Five neighbors are mowing and planting. One neighbor has structures on District property. Officers are working with the 5 neighbors to eliminate the encroachments.
