**RECOMMENDATION:** Recommend approval of a Resolution extending a Contract, retroactive from April 24, 2016 through April 23, 2018, to Obenauf Auction Services, Inc., Round Lake, Illinois, for auctioneer services.

## **STRATEGIC DIRECTION SUPPORTED:** Organizational Sustainability

**FINANCIAL DATA:** The cost of auctioneer services is detailed in Exhibit A attached to the Resolution and payment is collected from the gross proceeds from the sale of equipment, motor vehicles and other miscellaneous items. Net proceeds are remitted to the District and returned to the appropriate replacement fund or the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** Pursuant to Section 8(d) of the Downstate Forest Preserve District Act, 70 ILCS 804/0.001 et seq., whenever the District owns any personal property that is no longer necessary, useful to or for the best interests of the District, then three-fifths of the members of the District's Board of Commissioners, by an ordinance or resolution, may authorize the conveyance of sale of that personal property in any manner that they may designate, with or without advertising the sale.

The County of Lake publicly advertised for and solicited proposals for auctioneer services and, in the request for proposals, notified respondents that the services to be provided would also be offered for purchases to be made by other governmental units. Obenauf Auction Services, Inc. submitted a proposal to the County for auctioneer services which proposed to provide auctioneer services at the prices identified on Exhibit A attached hereto. The District entered into a Contract accordingly.

The original Resolution awarding Auctioneer Services to Obenauf Auction Services, Inc. was approved June 5, 2014, for a period of two years with an option to extend the contract for three additional one-year periods. District staff recommends approval of two one-year extensions.

## A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF A CONTRACT WITH OBENAUF **AUCTION SERVICES, INC., FOR AUCTIONEER SERVICES**

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2014, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") awarded a two-year contract for auctioneer services to Obenauf Auction Services, Inc. (the "Contract"), pursuant to which Obenauf Auction Services, Inc., agreed to provide auctioneer services for the sale of surplus District personal property (the "Services"); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Contract, the District has the option to renew the two-year Contract for three one-year extensions; and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to exercise its options to extend the Contract for two additional one-year terms, retroactive from April 24, 2016 through and including April 23, 2018 (the "Extension"):

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois, **THAT**:

Section 1: Recitals. The recitals set forth above are incorporated as a part of this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2: Approval of Extension. The Extension is hereby approved.

Section 3: Execution of Contract; Future Extension. The Executive Director and Secretary of the District are hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the Extension on behalf of the District. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to exercise the option to extend the Contract for a third one-year extension on behalf of the District.

<u>Section 4: Payments.</u> The District Treasurer shall make payments under the Contract only pursuant to and in accordance with the Contract terms.

Section 5: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.

#### Insurance:

The contractor must obtain, for the Contract term and any extension of it, insurance issued by a company or companies qualified to do business in the State of Illinois with an A.M. Best Rating of at least A- Insurance in the following types and amounts is necessary and/or where applicable:

## Workers Compensation (Coverage A) and Employers Liability (Coverage B)

Workers Compensation Insurance covering all liability of the Contractor arising under the Worker's Compensation Act and Worker's Occupational Disease Act at limits in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois. Employers' Liability Insurance shall be maintained to respond to claims for damages because of bodily injury, occupational sickness, or disease or death of the Contractor's employees, with limits listed below:

#### **Employers Liability**

- a) Each Accident \$1,000,000
- b) Disease-Policy Limit \$1,000,000
- c) Disease-Each Employee \$1,000,000

Such Insurance shall contain a waiver of subrogation in favor of Lake County.

#### Commercial General Liability Insurance

In a broad form on an occurrence basis shall be maintained, to include, but not be limited to, coverage for property damage, bodily injury (including death), personal injury and advertising injury in the following coverage forms where exposure exists:

- · Premises and Operations
- Independent Contractors
- Products/Completed Operations
- · Liability assumed under an Insured Contract/ Contractual Liability
- · Personal Injury and Advertising Injury

#### With limits of liability not less than:

- \$ 1,000,000 Each Occurrence
- \$ 1,000,000 Personal and Advertising injury limit
- \$ 2,000,000 General aggregate; the CGL policy shall be endorsed to provide that the General Aggregate limit applies separately to each of the contractor's projects away from premises owned or rented to contractor.

#### Automobile Liability Insurance

Automobile liability insurance shall be maintained to respond to claims for damages because of bodily injury, death of a person, or property damage arising out of ownership, maintenance, or use of a motor vehicle. This policy shall be written to cover any auto whether owned, leased, hired, or borrowed.

The Contractor's auto liability insurance, as required above, shall be written with limits of insurance not less than the following:

\$ 1,000,000 Combined single Limit (Each Accident)

## Care, Custody and Control Policy:

Contractor shall provide property damage coverage for any and all property /inventory of Lake County (including, but not limited to, motor vehicles) while said property /inventory is in the care, custody and control of Auctioneer with limits to match the value of the property/inventory being sold at auction.
