RECOMMENDATION: Approve termination of the existing Row Crop Farm License Agreements at Lake Marie and Ray Lake Forest Preserves.

STRATEGIC DIRECTIONS SUPPORTED: Conservation; Organizational Sustainability

FINANCIAL DATA: The existing Lake Marie and Ray Lake – Squaw Creek Farm License Agreements with Bradley Cockrum generate annual revenue of \$32,722.56 (157.32 acres at \$208.00/acre) and \$17,759.70 (84.57 acres at \$210.00/acre), respectively.


BACKGROUND: Under its farming program, the District licenses certain farmed lands that it acquires to farmers to provide cost-effective, interim land use management of such lands until the District is ready to convert such farmland to other forest preserve purposes.

On March 18, 2019, the District received a written notice from Bradley Cockrum requesting termination of their Farm License Agreements at Lake Marie and Ray Lake – Squaw Creek, due to financial hardship. They no longer have the financial ability to farm and are in the process of selling their farm equipment to settle outstanding debts from 2018. To date, Mr. Cockrum has complied with all District farm requirements and has paid all License Fees. District staff will place these licenses out to bid for approval at the May Operations Committee.
