RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of a Resolution approving a two-year CompleteLink Discount Pricing Schedule for Telephone Services with AT&T Corp.

STRATEGIC DIRECTION SUPPORTED: Organizational Sustainability

FINANCIAL DATA: The proposed pricing schedule defines the rates and discount that AT&T Corp. provides the District for telephone services during the two-year period of the schedule, pursuant to the District's Master Agreement with AT&T. This pricing schedule allows the District to maintain the current per line rate for all telephone services.

BACKGROUND: District staff has completed negotiations with AT&T Corp. for a CompleteLink discount pricing schedule that will be part of the District's existing 2009 Master Agreement with AT&T, resulting in no rate increase on telephone services for the next two years. The Master Agreement contemplates that the services provided to and paid for will be subject to periodic pricing schedules that will expire and be replaced over the term of the Master Agreement. The CompleteLink discount pricing schedule is based on the District continuing to purchase telephone services from AT&T Corp. for this two-year period.

Under the pricing schedule, the District will receive a 6% discount on phone line service and local and toll telephone call service. The T1/DS1 data and ASE fiber services the District purchases from AT&T contribute to the total required purchase for discount eligibility, but are discounted through separate agreements.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A TWO-YEAR COMPLETELINK DISCOUNT PRICING SCHEDULE WITH AT&T CORP.

WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") has entered into a Master Agreement with AT&T Corp., dated February 18, 2009 for the purchase of telecommunications services (the "Services"), subject to the then applicable pricing schedule agreed to by the parties (the "Master Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the District's staff has negotiated an amended CompleteLink Discount Pricing Schedule for the Master Agreement that will have a two-year term and replace the existing pricing schedule for the Master Agreement, in the form attached to this Resolution (the "New Discount Pricing Schedule"); and

WHEREAS, it is in the District's best interests to approve the New Discount Pricing Schedule in substantially the form attached hereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois, **THAT**:

Section 1: Recitals. The recitals set forth above are incorporated as a part of this Resolution by this reference.

<u>Section 2</u>: <u>Approval of New Discount Pricing Schedule</u>. The New Discount Pricing Schedule, in substantially the form attached hereto, is hereby approved. The District hereby finds that the New Discount Pricing Schedule is (i) germane to the Master Agreement as signed and (ii) in the best interest of the District.

<u>Section 3</u>: <u>Execution of New Discount Pricing Schedule</u>. The Executive Director of the District is hereby authorized and directed to execute the New Discount Pricing Schedule.

Section 4: Payments. The District Treasurer shall make payments under the Agreement only pursuant to and in accordance with the Agreement terms.

<u>Section 5:</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
