RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of a Resolution awarding a Contract for the Purchase of Trees and Shrubs for various Forest Preserves to Possibility Place Nursery, Inc. in the Contract Price of \$27,883.25.

STRATEGIC DIRECTION SUPPORTED: Conservation

FINANCIAL DATA: The District-wide Reforestation project was approved as part of the adopted FY22 Capital Improvement Plan in the amount of \$100,000.00. This portion of the project (purchase of trees) was estimated at \$40,000.00. The contract price of the proposed contract is \$27,883.25 which will be charged to the District-wide Reforestation account (1104100-803200-60008).

No other vendor submitted low bids exceeding \$25,000.00, so the low bids form those vendors (totaling \$11,972.43) do not require Committee and Board approval. Combined with the proposed contract, the total of the low bids is \$39,855.68, which will be charged to the Districtwide Reforestation account (1104100-803200-60008).

BACKGROUND: The District implements a reforestation program to (i) restore historically altered or degraded lands to their natural condition as forest, woodland, and savanna communities, (ii) reduce habitat fragmentation, (iii) restore woodland connectivity, (iv) enhance wildlife habitat, and (v) improve the aesthetic quality of its preserves. In the fall of 2022, 2,190 native trees and shrubs will be installed at Old School, Captain Daniel Wright Woods, Cuba Marsh, Fox River, Grant Woods, Ray Lake, and Edward L. Ryerson Conservation Area Forest Preserves across approximately 100 acres.

The project was advertised on January 26, 2022, and bids were received from five bidders each of which submitted bids on multiple species. The low bidders and their total bids are listed below:

Materials were bid on a unit price per species.

Staff recommends that Possibility Place Nursery, Inc. be awarded a contract as the lowest responsible bidder for the species for which it was the low bidder. Possibility Place Nursery, Inc. submitted low bids totaling greater than \$25,000.00, thus requiring Committee recommendation and Board approval of the contract with Possibility Place Nursery, Inc.

Delivery is anticipated to begin September 2022 and be completed by October 2022.

For this project, staff has already awarded contracts to Majestic Oaks Nursery and Johnson's Nursery, for the totals of their low bids. Each of their low bid totals is less than the Purchasing Policy threshold that requires Committee recommendation and Board approval (over \$25,000.00).

A RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR TREE AND SHRUB PURCHASES FOR MULTIPLE PRESERVES

WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") has advertised in <u>The Lake County News Sun</u> for sealed bids for the purchase of Trees and Shrubs identified on Exhibit A (the "Products"); and

WHEREAS, all sealed bids were received and opened by the District at its General Offices, 1899 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois on February 22, 2022 at 11:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the District's staff, the Purchasing Manager, the Director of Natural Resources, and the Operations Committee have reviewed the bids for the Products submitted by Possibility Place Nursery, Inc. and identified on Exhibit A (the "Bids") and recommend that the Board of Commissioners finds Possibility Place Nursery, Inc. to be the lowest responsible bidder for the Products, and awards a contract for the Products to Possibility Place Nursery, Inc. (the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that Possibility Place Nursery, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder for the Products;
