RECOMMENDATION: Recommend approval of an Ordinance providing for the Levy of Taxes for the Lake County Forest Preserve District for the Fiscal Year January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.

STRATEGIC DIRECTION SUPPORTED: Organizational Sustainability

FINANCIAL DATA: Provides the tax levy required to fund the 2023 Budget and the 2023 Annual Appropriation Ordinance.

BACKGROUND: The Annual Tax Levy Ordinance is the third step in the three-step process to complete the budget, appropriation and levy in accordance with District rules and State statutes. The District's Annual Budget, Appropriation, and Levy Ordinances will be presented to the Board for approval on October 11, 2022.

The General Corporate, Audit, Liability Insurance, Construction & Development, IMRF and FICA amount to be levied in 2022 for the 2023 fiscal year is \$27,337,020. This represents a \$648,974 (2.4%) increase from last year. The debt service levy is \$22,265,180 which is an increase of \$22,435 (0.1%) from last year. The combined levies total \$49,602,200, an increase of \$671,409 or 1.40% excluding the newly enacted recapture tax, which allows units of local government to recover losses from the prior year's assessment decreases resulting from certificates of error, court orders in tax objection cases, and final decisions of the Property Tax Appeal Board.

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES
FOR THE LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE DISTRICT
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JANUARY 1, 2023 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023**

WHEREAS, the sum of \$96,930,000 has been appropriated by the Lake County Forest Preserve District of Lake County, Illinois (the "District"), for the fiscal year January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 (the "Fiscal Year"), in the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the District for the Fiscal Year for corporate purposes of the District and for the objects and purposes therein stated, which Ordinance was duly passed and approved by the District Board of Commissioners at its meeting on October 11, 2022, and will thereafter be published by authority of said District according to law; and

WHEREAS, of the sum of \$96,930,000 legally appropriated by the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the Fiscal Year, the sum of \$49,602,200 is to be collected from real estate taxes to be levied in calendar year 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois, **THAT**:

Section 1: Recitals. The recitals set forth above are incorporated as part of this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2: Levy Amount. The sum of \$49,602,200 is hereby levied for the Fiscal Year commencing January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 against all property subject to taxation within the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized.

Section 3: Purpose of Levy. The purposes, for which the said amount of \$49,602,200 is hereby levied for the Fiscal Year, and the respective amounts thereof, are as follows:

Section 4: Filing. The Secretary of the Lake County Forest Preserve District is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance, along with the required certification by the presiding officer of the District pursuant to the Truth in Taxation Act, 35 ILCS 200/18-55, et. seq., with the County Clerk of Lake County, State of Illinois, as required by law, not later than December 27, 2022.

Section 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
