WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") owns certain surplus equipment, furnishings and other items described on the attached Exhibits A and B (collectively, the "Equipment"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that the Equipment has outlived its useful life or is surplus and that it is no longer necessary to, useful to, or for the best interest of the District; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the District to dispose of the Equipment as provided herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois, **THAT**:

Section 1: <u>Recitals.</u> The recitals set forth above are incorporated as part of this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2: Disposition of Equipment. The Executive Director, or his designee, is hereby authorized to (i) cause the Equipment described in Exhibit A to be auctioned "as is," individually or in one or more lots, to the highest bidder, (ii) cause the Equipment described in Exhibit B to be sold or donated "as is" to the parties described in Exhibit B, and (iii) discard any Equipment for which no suitable bids are received or that are not accepted.

Section 3: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
