**RECOMMENDATION:** Recommend approval of a \$1,000 grant from Unrestricted Funds to Support a Visitor Survey for the Bess Bower Dunn Museum.

**FINANCIAL DATA:** The requested funds will be paid in full in Spring 2023. As of December 31, 2022, the Foundation's total of unrestricted funding was \$445,754.06. Grants payable from the unrestricted funds as of December 31, 2022, include:

**BACKGROUND:** The American Alliance of Museums (AAM) recently announced that member museums can participate in a visitor survey. The survey is designed and conducted in partnership between Wilkening Consulting and the American Alliance of Museums and will be made available to Dunn Museum visitors. In addition to the receiving the data collected from our survey, Dunn Museum staff will benefit from information on how our data compares to other museums in the region. This would be the first in-depth survey of Dunn Museum visitors since the museum opened in 2018 and will serve establish a baseline for future surveys.

This opportunity is offered annually through AAM, though we have never participated. Beyond the typical survey questions, this year's survey has three themes that will provide keen insight into museum visitors and provide staff direction for the future. The themes are:

- Connection to humanity with the goal to understand what role the museum can play in cultivating a more emotionally connected humankind.
- Civic participation exploring how the museum might bring disparate viewpoints together in ways that promote a civic mindset.
- Rebuilding museum visitation to learn about opportunities to expand our audience.

This opportunity arose after approval of the current fiscal year budget. The Dunn Museum requests \$1,000 to participate in this opportunity in 2023. Funding for subsequent annual surveys will be included in future budget requests, and the repeated surveys will be used to monitor trends.
