**RECOMMENDATION:** Recommend Approval of an Ordinance Approving the 10-year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for Fiscal Year 2024 and Amending the Fiscal Year 2023 Budget and CIP.

<u>STRATEGIC DIRECTIONS SUPPORTED</u>: Public Access and Connections; Conservation; Leadership; Organizational Sustainability; Communication, Education and Outreach.

FINANCIAL DATA: As noted in Background (below) and on attached spreadsheet.

**BACKGROUND:** Under the District's budget process, including its Annual Budget Policies, the 10-year CIP is reviewed by the Operations, Planning, and Finance Committees and is then submitted to the full Board of Commissioners for review and approval. The approved CIP then serves as a guide for capital improvement projects included in the District's annual budget.

Part I below summarizes staff's proposed 2024 adjustments to projects that are included within the 2023 CIP, including reductions for completed projects.

Part II below summarizes staff's proposed amendments to the 2023 Budget and CIP that are necessary because of higher than expected bids and current economic conditions which increased the actual costs of certain capital projects. Specifically, staff recommends that the 2023 Budget and CIP be amended to include the new funding requested below for the Lakewood Grounds Maintenance Building and the Duck Farm Dog Exercise Area Accessibility Improvements.

## I. Recommended FY 2024 CIP Adjustments (vs. 2023 CIP):

Reductions in CIP amounts are in parentheses, and increases in CIP amounts are identified with a "+" sign:

1) <u>Duck Farm Munn Road Access – (\$66,532.04)</u>. As part of IDOT's road improvements to IL Route 132, the existing entrance to the Off-leash Dog Area was relocated to align with the

- existing traffic signal at Munn Road. The project was substantially completed in 2020 and the project budget can be partially reduced while holding approximately \$25,322.22 until final closeout is received from IDOT. This change will not impact annual operating costs.
- 2) Middlefork Savanna Trail Connection (\$32,392.04). This project involved a cooperative relationship with the City of Lake Forest, Lake Forest Openlands and private donors to construct a bridge over the Metra Railway allowing for the safe extension of a trail to Townline Community Park and the larger effort to connect Middlefork Savanna Forest Preserve and the Middlefork Trail and Greenway to the Des Plaines River Trail at MacArthur Woods Forest Preserve. The project was completed in the fall of 2017 and was closed out by IDOT with a budget surplus. The project budget can be reduced and closed out. This change will not impact annual operating costs.
- 3) Fort Sheridan Public Access Improvements (\$94,230.97). The 2015 Master Plan for Fort Sheridan Forest Preserve included accessibility improvements to the existing Hutchinson trail, a new birding loop trail, a new entrance drive, a new parking lot, two overlooks and a new restroom. With the installation of an accessible picnic table platform and additional tree planting in the fall of 2022, the project has been fully completed. Due to favorable bidding in 2016-2019 and good project management, the project budget can be reduced and closed out. This change will not impact annual operating costs.
- 4) Lyons Woods Trail Connection (\$184,984.56). In 2010, a master plan was approved for Waukegan Savanna Forest Preserve that included a regional trail connecting Lyons Woods and Waukegan Savanna Forest Preserves to the Des Plaines River Trail. The District partnered with the City of Waukegan, Waukegan Park District and Waukegan Township to complete a 2.5-mile section of trail between Lyons Woods and Green Bay Road. The project was funded in part by a grant through the Transportation Alternatives Program. The project was completed and open to the public in 2018 and the District recently received final billing and closeout documents from IDOT. Due to favorable bidding in 2017 and good project management, the project budget can be reduced and closed out. This change will not impact annual operating costs.
- 5) Lakewood Forest Preserve +\$309,190.00. In January 2020, the Board approved a comprehensive Master Plan for Lakewood Forest Preserve that identified significant improvements to the trails, picnic areas, roads, parking, utilities and other site work that will help to lower the long-term operating costs of the Preserve. Due to current economic conditions and recent bidding results, the Taylor Lake Shelter and the additional family shelter, originally part of the Phase I improvements, could not be constructed with the available CIP funding. Staff would like to apply for an IDNR Park and Recreation Facility Construction (PARC) grant for completion of the two shelters which could fund up to 75% of the total construction costs. Additional funding is needed to cover the cost of the local share/match for this grant opportunity. It is recommended that the revenue source for the additional funding occur through a transfer from the pavement replacement fund. A reduction in the annual operating costs is expected with the completion of the master plan improvements.
- 6) Millennium Trail McDonald Woods to Route 45 (\$83,082.24). As part of the planned Millennium trail extension connecting McDonald Woods, Raven Glen and Ethel's Woods Forest Preserves, the District partnered with IDOT and the Village of Lindenhurst to

incorporate a shared-use path within the Millburn bypass and Il Route 45 improvement project. The project was substantially completed in 2021 and the project budget can be partially reduced while holding approximately \$15,554.92 until final closeout is received from IDOT. This change will not impact annual operating costs.

7) <u>Habitat Restoration Projects – (\$23,478.06).</u> There were nine different site specific habitat restoration projects that were completed during the year and have been removed from the CIP.

#### II. Recommended Amendments to the Fiscal Year 2023 CIP:

- 1) <u>Lakewood Grounds Maintenance Building Replacement +\$2,500,000</u>. In January 2020, the Board approved a comprehensive Master Plan for Lakewood Forest Preserve that identified significant improvements to the trails, picnic areas, roads, parking, utilities and other site work that will help to lower the long-term operating costs of the Preserve. The Master Plan also included the construction of a new net-zero maintenance facility that would replace the existing maintenance building that was nearing the end of its useful life and no longer serves current needs. Due to current economic conditions and recent bidding results, additional funding is needed to complete the new building as authorized by the Board. It is recommended that the fund balance be reduced for the general fund and cost savings from existing completed projects be used to increase the project budget by \$2,500,000. It is anticipated that the new maintenance facility will achieve net-zero energy performance, setting the example for energy efficient design within the region and for future District infrastructure projects. When complete, this project will result in an overall reduction in the annual operating costs.
- 2) Duck Farm Dog Exercise Area Accessibility +\$25,000.00. In 2018, an evaluation was completed of all District facilities, preserves, programs and communications to determine the necessary improvements required to enhance compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Illinois Accessibility Code. Consistent with this evaluation, accessibility improvements are recommended, including a new entrance gate system, fencing, and accessible surfacing to the drinking fountain, restroom and seating area. Due to current economic conditions and recent bidding results, additional funding is needed to complete these improvements. This change will not impact annual operating costs.

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE 10-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (CIP) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET AND CIP

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Rules of Order and Operational Procedures of the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District"), the District's Finance Committee is responsible for recommending budget and appropriations ordinances to the District's Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the District's Standing Committees have reviewed and recommend approval of the prioritized 10-Year Capital Improvement Plan attached hereto (the "2024 CIP"), which includes a list of capital improvement projects (the "CIP Projects"); and

WHEREAS, the CIP Projects meet the criteria for public access and connections, conservation, leadership, organizational sustainability, communication, education and outreach; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 CIP will provide an important and useful planning guide for the preparation and approval of the District's annual budget ordinance;

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2022, the District's Board of Commissioners (the "Board"), by resolution, approved the District's 10-Year Capital Improvement Plan for the 2023 Fiscal Year Budget (the "2023 CIP") and, on October 11, 2022, the Board, by ordinance, approved the District's 2023 Fiscal Year Budget, incorporating the 2023 CIP (the "2023 Budget"); and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the District to amend the 2023 Budget and the 2023 CIP to authorize, in fiscal year 2023, the expenditure of (i) an additional amount not to exceed \$2,500,000.00 for the construction of the Grounds Maintenance Building Replacement at Lakewood Forest Preserve and (ii) an additional amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 for the construction of the Dog Exercise Accessibility Improvements at Duck Farm Forest Preserve;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The recitals set forth above are incorporated as a part of this Ordinance by this reference.

<u>Section 2:</u> <u>Approval of 2024 CIP.</u> The 2024 CIP is hereby approved in the form attached hereto. The Board, Standing Committees, and staff shall use the 2024 CIP as a planning guide for the preparation and approval of the District's annual budget ordinance.

### **Section 3: Amendment of 2023 CIP.** The 2023 CIP is hereby amended by:

(i) for the "Lakewood Grounds Maintenance Building Replacement" project (a) at page 213 of the 2023 Budget, amending the project line under "Public Access/Misc. Projects"

called "Lakewood Grounds Maintenance Building Replacement", to add \$2,500,000.00 to the line under column titled "Other Funds" and (b) at page 215 of the 2023 Budget, to add \$2,500,000.00 to the same project line under line item "General & Other Funds", under the section titled "Source of Funds", in the column titled "New Funding 2023" and

(ii) for the "Duck Farm Dog Exercise Area Accessibility" project (a) at page 213 of the 2023 Budget, amending the project line under "Public Access/Misc. projects" called "Duck Farm Dog Exercise Area Accessibility", to add \$25,000.00 to the line under column titled "General Fund" and (b) at page 215 of the 2023 Budget, to add \$25,000.00 to the same project line under line item "General & Other Funds", under section titled "Source of Funds", in column titled "New Funding 2023".

The Executive Director or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to make any further amendments to the 2023 CIP necessary or appropriate to reflect the amendments provided in this Section 3.

<u>Section 4:</u> <u>Amendment of 2023 Budget.</u> The Executive Director or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to make any further amendments to the 2023 Budget necessary or appropriate to reflect the amendments and transfers provided for in Section 3 of this Ordinance.

Section 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
