**RECOMMENDATION:** Recommend Approval of a Resolution Awarding Contracts for Native Seed Purchases for Multiple Preserves to Prairie Moon Nursery in the Contract Price of \$107,059.27 and Shooting Star Native Seeds, Inc. in the Contract Price of \$31,897.15.

#### STRATEGIC DIRECTION SUPPORTED: Conservation

FINANCIAL DATA: The purchase and delivery of native seed for the projects described in the Background section below were approved as part of the adopted FY24 budget. The estimated cost for seed was \$200,000.00. The actual cost for the purchase and delivery of native seed for the various projects under the contracts that would be approved by the attached resolution is \$138,956.42. The bids under \$30,000.00 that do not require Committee recommendation and Board approval total \$60,901.45, and combined with the contracts that would be approved by the attached resolution, total \$199,857.87.

BACKGROUND: The District will install native seed purchased through the proposed contracts in the fall of 2024 at MacArthur Woods, Oriole Grove, Heron Creek, Van Patten Woods, Greenbelt, and Grant Woods Forest Preserves as part of ongoing ecological restoration efforts. Additionally, a small amount of seed will be purchased to support in-house natural resource management projects and volunteer efforts following various habitat restoration efforts. Seed installation will occur across more than 504 acres.

The project was advertised on January 12, 2024, and bids from seven bidders were received. Materials were bid on a unit price per species. A summary of the lowest bidders and totals of their low bids is listed below:

RIDDERS WITH LOW RIDS LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO

For this project, staff has already awarded contracts to Minnesota Native Landscapes, Inc. dba MNL, RES Great Lakes, Millborn Seeds, Inc., and Genesis Nursery, Inc. For each bidder, the contract price is the total of its low bids and, in each case, the contract price is less than the Purchasing Policy threshold that requires Committee recommendation and Board approval (over \$30,000.00).

Prairie Moon Nursery and Shooting Star Native Seeds, Inc. each submitted total low bids greater than \$30,000.00, thus requiring Committee recommendation and Board approval of the resolution accepting those bids and approving their contracts. Staff recommends that Prairie Moon Nursery and Shooting Star Native Seeds, Inc. each be awarded a contract as the lowest responsible bidder for the species for which it was the low bidder.

Delivery is anticipated to begin after November 1, 2024 and to be completed by December 15, 2024.

## A RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR NATIVE SEED PURCHASES FOR MULTIPLE PRESERVES

WHEREAS, the Lake County Forest Preserve District (the "District") has advertised in The Lake County News Sun for sealed bids to purchase the native seed species identified on Exhibit A for installation at multiple Forest Preserves (the "Products"); and

WHEREAS, all sealed bids were received and opened by the District at its General Offices, 1899 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois, on January 29, 2024 at 11:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the District's staff, the Purchasing Manager, the Director of Natural Resources, and the Operations Committee have reviewed the bids identified in Exhibit A and recommend that the Board of Commissioners finds (i) Prairie Moon Nursery to be the lowest responsible bidder with respect to the bids that it submitted that are listed on Exhibit A in the table titled "Vendor: Prairie Moon Nursery" (the "Prairie Moon Bids"), and (ii) Shooting Star Native Seeds, Inc. to be the lowest responsible bidder with respect to the bids that it submitted that are listed on Exhibit A in the table titled "Vendor: Shooting Star Native Seeds, Inc." (the "Shooting Star Bids"), and award contracts for the Products to these bidders consistent therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that Prairie Moon Nursery and Shooting Star Native Seeds, Inc. are the lowest responsible bidders for the Products as stated in the previous clause;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Lake County Forest Preserve District, Lake County, Illinois, **THAT**:

<u>Section 1:</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The recitals set forth above are incorporated as a part of this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2: Award of Contract. The Prairie Moon Bids in the total amount of \$107,059.27 (the "Prairie Moon Contract Price") are hereby accepted, and a contract in the amount of the Prairie Moon Contract Price is hereby awarded to Prairie Moon Nursery (the "Prairie Moon Contract") for purchase of the associated Products listed on Exhibit A. The Shooting Star Bids in the total amount of \$31,897.15 (the "Shooting Star Contract Price") are hereby accepted, and a contract in the amount of the Shooting Star Contract Price is hereby awarded to Shooting Star Native Seeds, Inc. (the "Shooting Star Contract") for purchase of the associated Products listed on Exhibit A (collectively, the Prairie Moon Contract and Shooting Star Contract are the "Contracts.")

<u>Section 3:</u> <u>Execution of Contracts.</u> The Executive Director of the District is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Contracts for the Products in the amounts of the Prairie Moon Contract Price and Shooting Star Contract Price.

<u>Section 4: Payments.</u> The Treasurer shall make payments under the Contracts only pursuant to and in accordance with the Contracts' terms.
